


PLANNING YOUR LEGACY WHY A WILL?

Include every one.




3 WITHOUT A WILL

Court decides based on Distribution Act. Court process may take time. Only legal heirs inherit. Higher risk.



4 REQUIREMENTS OF A WILL

You will have to be above 21 years old. Be of sound mind. Voluntarily make a will, no coercion. Sign in the presence of 2 witnesses (professionals).
